

Schaumburg Christian Day Camp 2022 Health & Safety Guidelines

At Schaumburg Christian Day Camp, we will strive to maintain a safe and healthy environment for our employees, students, and their families during the summer. In helping us do this, please familiarize yourself with our current guidelines we have in place for Day Camp 2022.

Please do not enter our facilities if you are sick

We ask that individuals not enter our facilities until you are completely symptom free for 24 hours **without the use of symptom suppressing medication.**

If your child has tested positive for Covid-19, they must complete a 5 calendar day quarantine, be fever, vomiting, and diarrhea free (for 24hrs without the use of symptoms suppressing medication), and recovering well from any other symptoms before entering our facilities.

Hand Hygiene

Schaumburg Christian Day Camp will continue to encourage frequent proper hand washing. Soap, paper towels, hand sanitizer, tissues, etc., will be in all common areas of the building. Hand washing with soap and water is always the first recommended line of defense, but where this is not feasible or readily accessible, the use of hand sanitizer will be used. Additionally, students will be directed and encouraged to avoid touching the face (eye, nose, mouth) to decrease the transmission of infectious diseases.

Facility-wide Cleaning and Disinfecting

Schaumburg Christian Day Camp will continue frequent cleaning and disinfecting. This cleaning and disinfecting will include touched surfaces (e.g., door handles/knobs, desktops/tabletops, counter tops, light switches, pencil sharpeners, computer keyboards, hands-on learning items, phones, toys, cubbies/coat and backpack areas, sinks and faucets, buses/vans) on a daily basis. Schaumburg Christian Day Camp will be using EPA-approved disinfectants.
